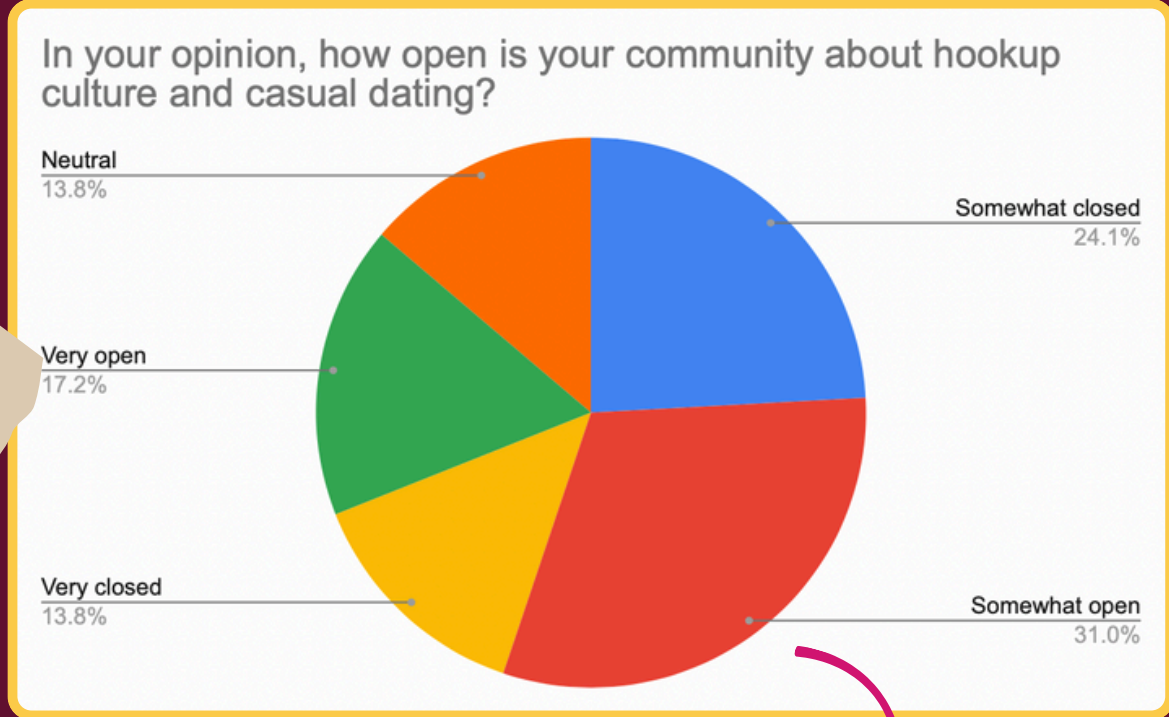




So far, you can see a common trend within Black communities' views on hookup culture: men tend to have a more positive outlook, while women are generally more negative about it.



From my survey, male-identifying students, when asked if they thought their community was open to hookup culture, tended to answer with 'Very open,' 'Somewhat open,' or 'Neutral.' In contrast, female-identifying students leaned more towards 'Very closed,' 'Somewhat closed,' or 'Neutral.'
